About the Upward Bound/HCOP Summer Residential Programs

The Upward Bound/HCOP summer residential program is a six-week residential academic opportunity for high school students on the San Diego State campus, providing classroom and life skills for their success.

In addition to a rigorous academic curriculum, we provide a college-simulated, residential experience to 90 eligible students from San Diego City Schools, Grossmont Union High School and Sweetwater Union High School districts. The program focus is to prepare students to pursue a postsecondary education.

Qualifications

- BA BS in a science related, health or allied health field.
- Teaching credential or Masters Degree.
- At least 3 years teaching experience.
- Experience teaching at secondary level (10 - 12th grade).
- Experience with participant population (low income, diverse, ELL).
- Ability to support students in the analysis, reporting and presenting of research.
- Understanding of basic statistics and good writing and communication skills.
