We invite you to apply to become either a mathematics or literacy tutor for middle school students in the Sweetwater Union High School District!

This is your opportunity to serve as a role model for students and use your understanding of mathematics or literacy to help middle school students learn. We will support your work as a tutor, so even if you have never tutored in mathematics or language arts before, you will become well qualified for the position.

As a Tutor you will earn about \$10 per hour, work with students, and get the opportunity to learn about teaching, tutoring, schools, and mathematics or language arts. The funding for this program is paid for in part by federal work-study funds. The position requires enrollment in a TE 362 course and an all day retreat on Saturday, September 10, 2005. The position also requires a time commitment of at least 10 hours a week between the middle school hours of 8am to 3pm.

We are accepting applications for priority consideration through July . If you are eligible for financial aid and/ or student loans but are uncertain about your Federal Work Study eligibility, we can assist you.
